EXTERNAL RE-DECORATION OF HOUSES

With hopefully the Spring about to be upon us, the Local Authority have again asked us to point out that the re-decoration of houses externally requires the consent of the Local Planning Authority. This is because Brentham is a Conservation Area and there is an Article 4 Direction in force, and one of the items included within this Direction refers to the external decoration of houses.
