## BONFIRES

There have been a few cases of nuisance on the Estate caused by bonfires and a committee member contacted the Council's Chief Officer of Health for guidance. His reply was too long to repeat here in full, but practical guidelines are well covered in this extract:-

Occupiers of premises, both in Smoke Control Areas and elsewhere are urged to observe the following simple conditions, before lighting fires in the open:-

- a) Choose the site for your bonfire carefully having due regard for those living nearby.
- b) Never light a bonfire unless you are satisfied that weather conditions and wind direction are such that any smoke or ash will be carried away from your neighbours' windows and gardens. Make sure that there is no laundry drying in any adjoining gardens.
- c) Only use material which is dry enough to enable it to be burned quickly and with a minimum of smoke.
- d) Soft vegetable waste and grass cuttings etc., which are difficult to dry, should be composted or buried.
- e) Do not burn oily rags, rubber and other materials likely to produce heavy or pungent smoke.
- f) If, in spite of taking the above precautions, your bonfire smoulders, put it out and wait for the material to dry before starting another fire.

Your attention is drawn to the very high fine, up to £1,000, which could be levied in cases of nuisance.

DUMPING OF REFUSE

You will have noticed that the rubbish dumped in front of the two lock-up garages in Pitshanger Lane (almost opposite Ludlow Road) has been cleared away.

Following protests from the Brentham Society, the Bradford Property Trust (the owners of the garages) cleared the mess.

Once illegal tipping becomes established it can be difficult to eradicate so it is important that, if further rubbish is allowed to accumulate, you should complain to the owners, whose telephone number is 997 4422.

OAK DISEASE

Last year there were many queries about the disease affecting the acorns on the oak tree on the Green between Ludlow and Denison Roads. This is caused by a gall wasp and is always much worse in wet summers. The effect is only an annual event, that is, acorns of the following year can be perfect, and the tree itself is quite unaffected.
