## GOOD WISHES FOR 1993 TO ALL RESIDENTS OF THE BRENTHAM ESTATE

### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The meeting was held at the Brentham Club on November 12 1992 and the hall was full. Last year's AGM minutes and the Treasurer's Report were accepted as presented.

The meeting approved one change in your committee: Barbara Murray wished to retire after many years of dedicated service to this Society. This was accepted with much regret. Tony Oliver expressed our thanks to Barbara and presented her with a gift token. Gunda Cannon was elected as Secretary.

Tony Oliver also presented a bottle of champagne to Charles Rigg as a token of our appreciation for his many years of service as Area Co-ordinator for the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme.

The problem of cycling on pavements was discussed although no immediate solution was forthcoming. It was considered, that in view of the dangers from traffic, parents would continue to allow their younger children to cycle on the pavement.

The question of through traffic using Meadvale Road was raised. It was suggested that traffic calming measures should be investigated. Residents views on this matter would be appreciated.

Several residents voiced concern over inadequate street lighting. The Committee promised to look into possible improvements.

### FENCES AND GATES

It has been noticed that certain alterations have been carried out to fences and gates on the estate without reference first being made to the Council's Planning Department. Residents may like to be reminded that permission is required for the erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or hedges, or other means of enclosure, whether at the front, side, or rear of the property. Advice should first be sought before any such work is carried out.
