The 1911 Census

The data presented here has been extracted from the 1911 census records accessed through www.1911census.co.uk and www.findmypast.co.uk

At the time of the census, Sunday 2nd April 1911, Brentham was still under construction. It is estimated that there were in the region of 360 completed houses. The census recorded just under 330 households. While some households would have been absent on the night of the census and hence not recorded, some houses would have been built but not yet occupied.

There was nothing built in Denison Road, Fowlers Walk, Holyoake Walk or North View and only 3 houses in Brentham Way. Meadvale Road was only partially complete.

The following pages give an analysis of people and households recorded.

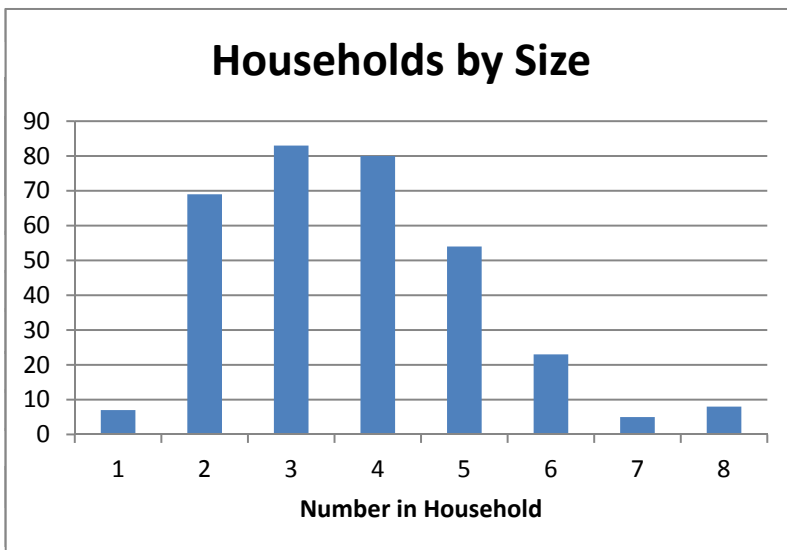

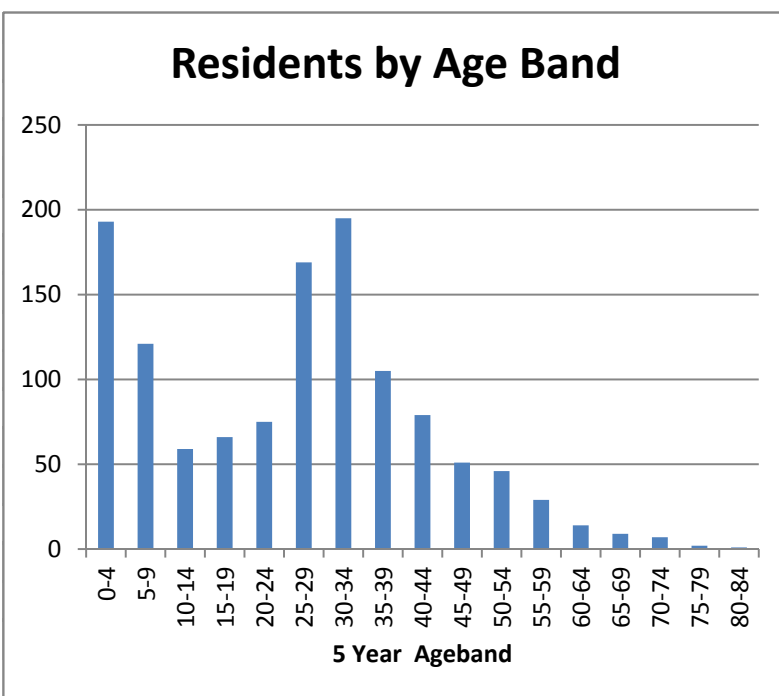
