The 1911 Census

The data presented here has been extracted from the 1911 census records accessed through www.1911census.co.uk and www.findmypast.co.uk

At the time of the census, Sunday 2nd April 1911, Brentham was still under construction. It is estimated that there were in the region of 360 completed houses. The census recorded 336 households. While some households would have been absent on the night of the census and hence not recorded, some houses would have been built but not yet occupied.

There was nothing built in Fowlers Walk, Holyoake Walk or North View. Only 3 houses in Brentham Way were completed and a further 20 were under construction. Meadvale Road was only partially complete with 7 under construction.

Note: some properties were renumbered or the street renamed post 1911:
1-5 Brunswick Road were recorded in the census as 1-5 Fowlers Walk and
33,34,35,36,37 Brunner Road were recorded as 45,33,34,35,36 Brunner Road

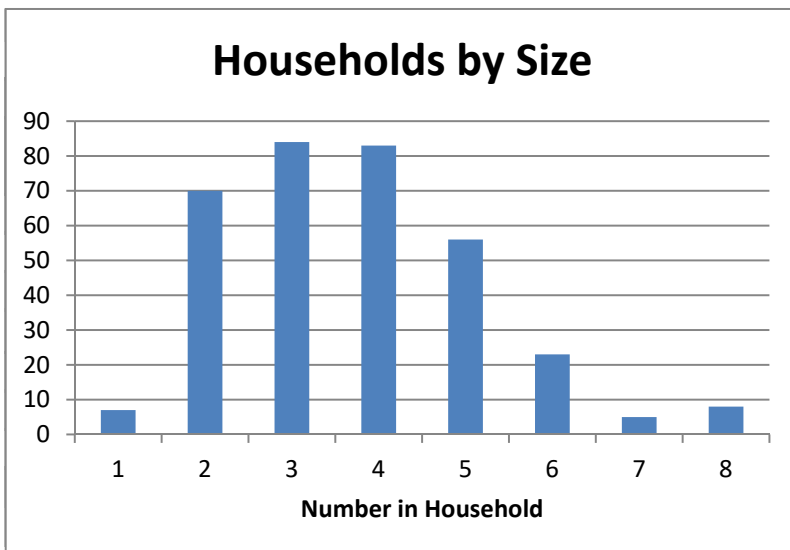

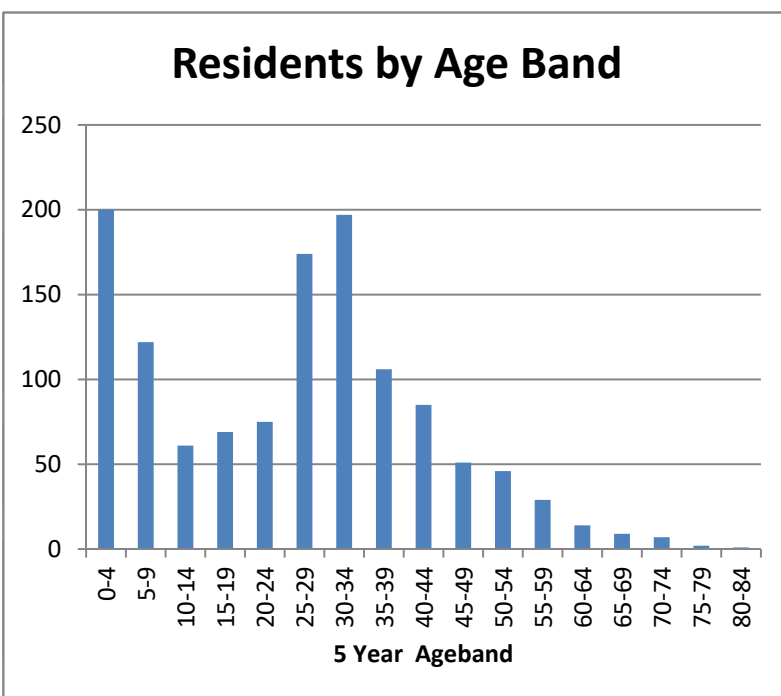
